cil for the Arab States of the Gulf to the same extent,
and subject to the same conditions, as they may be ex tended to a public international organization in which the
United States participates pursuant to any treaty or under
the authority of any Act of Congress authorizing such par ticipation or making an appropriation for such participa tion.".
