16 **Subtitle H—Baltic Reassurance Act**

17 **SEC. 1271. FINDINGS.**

18 Congress finds the following:

19 (1) Russia seeks to diminish the North Atlantic
20 Treaty Organization (NATO) and recreate its sphere
21 of influence in Europe using coercion, intimidation,
22 and outright aggression.

23 (2) Deterring Russia from such aggression is
24 vital for transatlantic security.
