BINDING MOTION ON JASTA
Adopted by the Second Chamber of the Dutch Parliament
Initiated by the Member Jeroen Recourt (Labour Party)

The Chamber,

after hearing the deliberations,

noting that the US House of Representatives as part of its considerations with regards to the Justice Against Sponsors of Terrorism Act (JASTA) is organizing a hearing;

considering that JASTA can lead to liability in the United States for actions of the Dutch Government within the territory of the Netherlands and can subsequently lead to astronomical damages;

considering that JASTA represents a gross and unwanted breach of Dutch sovereignty;

declares that the entry into force of JASTA in its current form is unacceptable for the Netherlands;

also declares that this position is expressed at the House of Representatives' hearing on JASTA preferably by the Dutch parliament, or alternatively on behalf of the Dutch Government,

and proceeds with the order of the day,
